



PROJECTS IN THE YEAR 2016-2017

VILLAGE CENTERS

KIDS

Kids in the age group of 3 to 6 are naturally eager for knowledge and making them learn in a thoughtfully prepared environment makes the whole concept of learning a joyful process at Vidyarambam. In their early childhood, Vidyarambam children learn through sensory-motor activities and work with various specially designed materials that develop their cognitive powers. The curriculum incorporates learning numbers and language using play way methods in a regular school environment.



SUPPORT CLASS JUNIOR (SCJ)

Class 2 and Class 3 students of rural schools were enrolled here and the teachers matched appropriate lessons from the school curriculum with the Vidyarambam material whereby learning became more practical and was naturally absorbed and internalised. Children learnt the basic concepts of Mathematics and they were also trained to read fluently in Tamil and English. The Phonetic method to learn English words helped the children to learn the language in a simpler way.



SUPPORT CLASS SENIOR (SCS)

Support class senior comprised of class 4 and class 5 students. Here too, the school curriculum is integrated with Vidyarambam materials and children acquired different concepts of Mathematics through hands-on learning which is more practical and application oriented. Children worked individually and in groups that lead to a deeper understanding of language, Mathematics, Science, Music and much more. Children learnt the basic concepts of English Grammar using different materials that made the learning more effective and enjoyable.



MODEL FULL TIME ENGLISH MEDIUM SCHOOL (RVS)

The full-time Primary school for the children of Tsunami affected families and nearby fishing communities was launched in the year 2008 at Nagapattinam and has been imparting free value education for many years now that has empowered the less privileged children with knowledge and excellence.



The curriculum is designed in such a way that the three dimensions of learning - Academics, Extra-curricular activities and Sports are given importance which results in a well-balanced program for children. Academics are taught to children in a more practical and joyful environment using indigenous Vidyarambam kits and also through audio-visual presentations. The school focuses on the Holistic development of the children wherein the children are encouraged to involve in diverse activities that include Gardening, playing long-established in-door



games like Pallangkuzhi (பல்லாங்குழி), Pambaram (பம்பரம்), Chess, Carrom, drawing traditional art-forms like Rangoli (கோலம்), creating numerous Arts and Crafts, maintaining the School campus and also taking turns to conduct the School Assembly every day. Their Physical and Mental discipline is instilled by practising Yogasana every day and the school also has a well-stocked Library that inculcates the Reading habit in children in augmenting their knowledge. As said by Hodding Carter, There are two things we should give our children, one is 'roots' and the other is 'Wings'. Going by the saying, Vidyarambam aims to endow students with Knowledge, Creativity, Innovation, Discipline and a Sense of Responsibility.

MOBILE TOY VAN

The Mobile Toy Van of Vidyarambam shuttles from village to village with about 250 educational and scientific toys and games kindling the enthusiasm and curiosity of children in the rural areas. The games and toys have been carefully chosen to make their learning practical and joyful, opening their minds to see beyond their immediate settings and environment and making them fly on the wings of imagination.

Children are encouraged to play with these Mind bending Toys for about 2 hours. The Brain storming games like the Memory retention games, Arithmetic games, Word building, jigsaw puzzles etc. develop hand-muscle coordination, activate the left and right brain thereby enriching the imagination and creativity in children. A firm foundation is offered to kids and it enables hands on learning through play way method on basic concepts in Math and English language. These toys aim at encouraging children to probe beyond the obvious objectives through discussions and reasoning which leads to the development of their linguistic skills too.

This is a boon for the little ones who do not have access to any such play material. At the end of the session within the school, the Vidyarambam Tutors who accompany the toy van spend "circle time" with the children, singing songs which helps in reinforcing the concepts that they have just learnt.

Vidyarambam is successful in alleviating the fear and hatred towards Education among the rural children by showing them that learning is an interesting aspect in their life. If children can be tapped at the right age and when learning becomes joyful, the hidden talents of the young minds start to bloom and this thirst for knowledge is infused in children once they become a part of Vidyarambam centres.



Village Library

A library was set up in each village having a learning centre, to cater children's story books and novels to people in the village. Anybody from the village could access the books for free.

Easy Learning English (ELE)

Goal

- Make the process of learning English as a second language more enjoyable
- Ability to read and write in English and achieve a certain amount of fluency in conversing in English
- Negate the fear of learning English which directly reflects in the drop-out rates in schools

Objective

The ELE program has been designed in such a way that the goals mentioned above could be achieved within a specified time frame. The objective of achieving the short-term and long term goals during the program has been planned systematically by drafting specific steps which gets monitored at the end of every week. The teachers get ample support from the ELE trainers who help them to achieve the weekly objectives by clearing their doubts and guiding them at every step.

HeadStart (HS)

HeadStart is an off shoot of ELE program. This new initiative aims to dispel the fear of English among rural children. At the Heart of the program is 'Phonics', a globally proven methodology customized by Vidyarambam for rural students. The 20 session program has been designed and will be delivered to STD IV and STD V students across the state which will focus on imparting skills to read English words using innovative teaching methodologies and write simple sentences in English.

Easy Learning Maths (ELM)

Goal

Four levels of skill level are targeted across the primary levels (based on appropriate grade level):

- Number sense
- Measurement
- Geometry (Spatial)

Objective

To teach Mathematics in a fun way covering a broad range of knowledge and skills and at the same time eliminating the phobia associated with the subject. The program works hand in hand with the State Board syllabus and supports class room teaching with interactive fun based activities and games. The program covers the basic tenets of seeing, hearing, and doing Maths by deriving inspiration from nature, everyday objects, around us. The program provides a strong foundation in the subject that forms the basis to succeed as these children get to higher grades and face increased complexity in Maths.

School Model Learning Centre (SMLC)

The main objective of Vidyarambam's SMLC program during school hours is to integrate the State Board syllabus with the Vidyarambam Material. Under the able guidance of academic experts, Vidyarambam has designed educational kits for various age groups starting from kids to seniors. As and when concepts are introduced in the classroom according to the Samacheer Syllabus, Vidyarambam teachers impart the same concepts to children by using the corresponding material from the educational kit. This hands-on method of learning makes learning easier, practical and enjoyable. 'Do and Understand' is the motive behind using relevant materials to learn English Grammar and mathematical concepts like Number system, Fractions etc. and not just stop with 'Talk and Chalk' method that is extensively adopted in most of the schools.

Rotary Vidyarambam School witnessed the following events in the year 2016-17.

The School reopened for this academic year in June 2016 and the Students were given a warm welcome. Parents, Teachers, Principal, Correspondent, General Manager and some district Coordinators participated in Parent –Teachers meeting. During the month of



August 'Project Day' was celebrated. The 4th and 5th standard students of the nearby Samanthanpettai. Govt School were invited for this event and our school students showcased their experiments in Science, Maths and Social Science that enabled a healthy exchange of knowledge among children. Teachers were trained by District Coordinators to include Vidyarambam materials in their teaching methodology.

Our Founder Late Mr. Ranganathan's Birthday was celebrated on 27th August and a coconut sapling was planted in his remembrance.



Our President.C.K. Sridhar visited the school, interacted with teachers and children and learnt about their progress. He made arrangements to put up a fence around the School Garden and also sponsored a cupboard to display the exhibits at school.



During the second term in October, Parent-Teachers meeting was held to give feedback about children's academic performance to parents. VadakudiPanchayat Head Mr.Gunasekaran visited the school and talked to 4th and 5th STD children about the role of Panchayat and governance in villages.



He highlighted the social responsibility and duties of every civilian as a native of a particular village. His visit proved very helpful to children as they could relate his speech to their lessons in Social Science on Panchayat and Village Governance.



Children's day was celebrated. A 'Traditional Game Fair' was hosted on this special day for children. This event was hosted to revive the traditional games of TamilNadu which is slowly fading away from our minds. Children from the nearby Government school were invited on this day and all our children played games like Gilli, Pambaram, Paandi, and Pallankuzhi and thoroughly enjoyed the day.



A 'free medical Camp' by the Government Medical team was organised and the children underwent a free medical check-up and later the reports were sent to Parents also.



Our Founder Mr.Ranganathan's death anniversary was observed on 25th December.

Teachers were trained to handle English language in a more interactive method in classrooms by our Correspondent Mrs.PremaVeeraraghavan and Special Faculty Mrs.Srimathi Devarajan.



Ms.Iswarya from GiveIndia visited the School and was very happy interacting with teachers and children.

Children participated in different competitions and displayed their skills in Sports Day. They also happily involved themselves in making a cycle in the class room activity.



Republic Day was celebrated.



RV School 'Annual day' was celebrated and Honourable Justice, Mr. P.N. Prakash, Madras High Court was the Chief Guest for the event. Mr. Sri Sridharan, Pratham USA also presided over the function and gave away the prizes.



Teachers Training Programme

As part of our continued endeavour to support new learning and improved skills of our teachers, a 3 day training programme was conducted in December 2016 at Vidyarambam, Chennai. This programme brought together Coordinators and Assessors of different districts to share and exchange knowledge through interactive sessions under the able guidance of our mentor Mrs.PremaVeeraraghavan.



To help children perform better in their academics, the idea of integrating Vidyarambam material with Samacheer Syllabus has been introduced from this year. A detailed syllabus was drawn for subjects like English, Tamil and Maths for children of different age groups comprising of Kids, Junior and Senior.



The Programme was divided into 4 sessions every day and each district Coordinator along with their respective team chose a subject and demonstrated different concepts covered in the textbook along with the Vidyarambam material. This teaching methodology helped the children to learn the concepts in a more practical way and it paved way for a more interactive atmosphere in the classroom. When Children involved themselves in hands-on training, it made them think, understand and question which resulted in a more value-oriented sessions in the classroom.




Henceforth, it has been decided that for every term, a detailed syllabus would be prepared and all the districts would follow this pattern of teaching in their respective centres.




Support Class Senior Performance Chart for grade IV and V Students

1. The accounts of the Trust is prepared under historical cost convention on accrual basis of accounting, except for fees collection in Rotary Vidyarambam School at Nagapattinam. 2. The information regarding the existing and new projects started during the year by the Trust is provided in the annual report
3. The Trust has approval under section 80G of the IT Act, 1961 Vide DIT (E) NO: 2 (35) 04-05 valid in perpetuity
4. The Trust has got approval under section 35 AC of the IT Act, 1961 Vide Order NO: 83/ 2011/ F. No.V270/04/2008 valid till 31-03-2017
5. Details about donations received in kind and their utilisation is maintained seperately and the same is not brought in books.
6. **Fixed Assets :**
Fixed Assets are shown at cost less depreciation. The Trust capitalizes all costs of acquisition and installation of Fixed Assets including charges.
7. **Depreciation :**
Depreciation in respect of Fixed Assets is provided for on Written Down Value Method at the rates and in the manner specified under Income Tax Rules 1962.
8. **Foreign Currency Donations**
The Trust has permanent registration under Foreign Contribution Regulation Act, 1976 and received donations in foreign currency during the year.
9. Previous Years figures have been re grouped / re - classified wherever necessary to suit the current year headings and terminology.
